- Introduce key components of IKS, such as Philosophy and Spirituality Science and Technology Arts and Culture

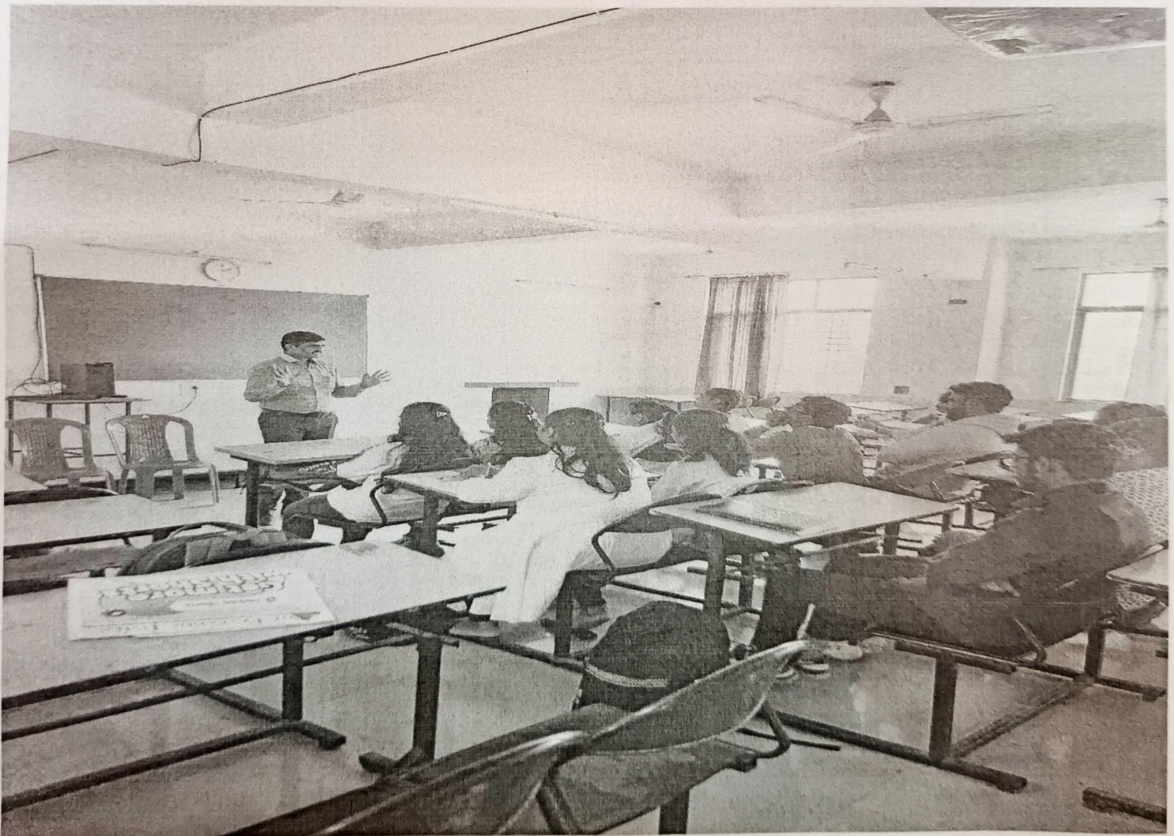
About The Program:

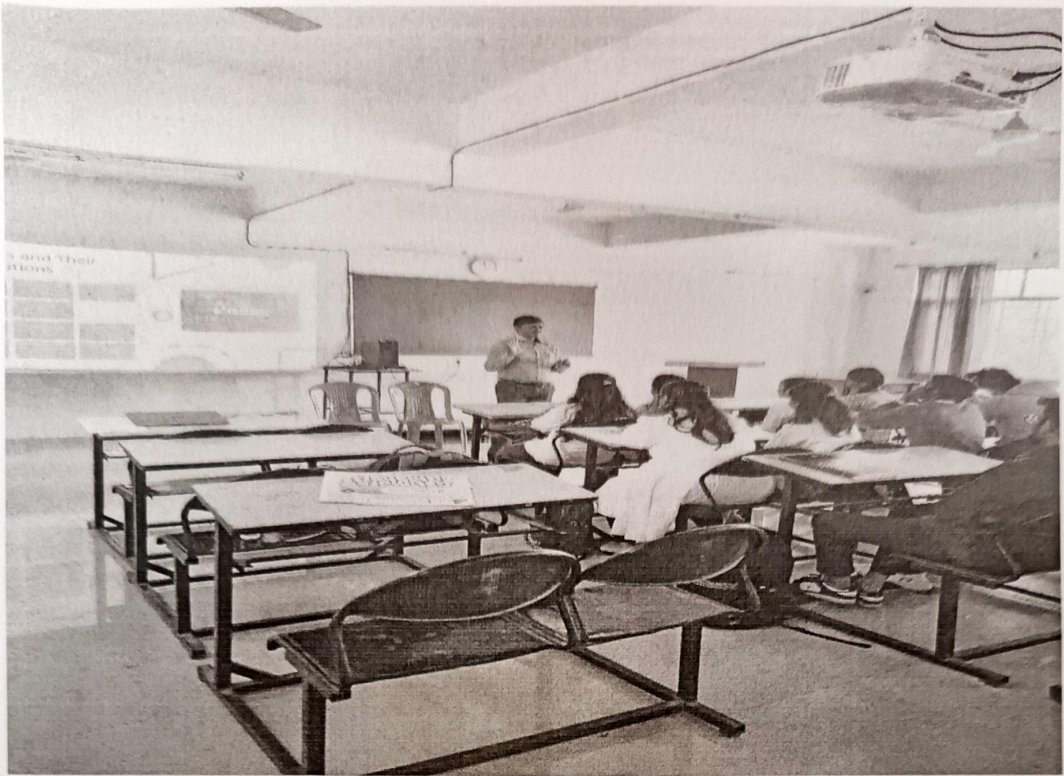
