The Regional Roundtable Meeting was held on 12th May 2026 at Loknete Gopinathji Munde Institute of Engineering Education and Research from 3:00 PM onwards. The theme of the roundtable meeting was **“Management Education in a Changing and Challenging Decade: Building the Talent Pipeline and Corporate Alignment.”**

Principal, Dr. K.V. Chandratre, felicitate all the dignitaries, panel members, academicians and industry experts. Dr Sarika Patil HOD of MBA commenced the meeting with warmly welcoming all the guests and introduced the esteemed speakers and panel members to the audience. He provided valuable insights into the importance of collaboration between academia and industry to bridge the talent gap and enhance employability among management graduates.

The panel discussion was initiated by Dr Sarika Patil by asking the questions to panel member like How can management education adapt to the rapidly changing global business environment?, How can management schools build an industry-ready talent pipeline for future workforce demands?, What strategies can be adopted to align management education with technological advancements and digital transformation? etc.

His energetic interaction created a positive environment and encouraged students to develop confidence, resilience and a growth-oriented mindset.

Ltd. emphasized the importance of developing industry-oriented curricula that focus on practical exposure, innovation and leadership skills among management students.
